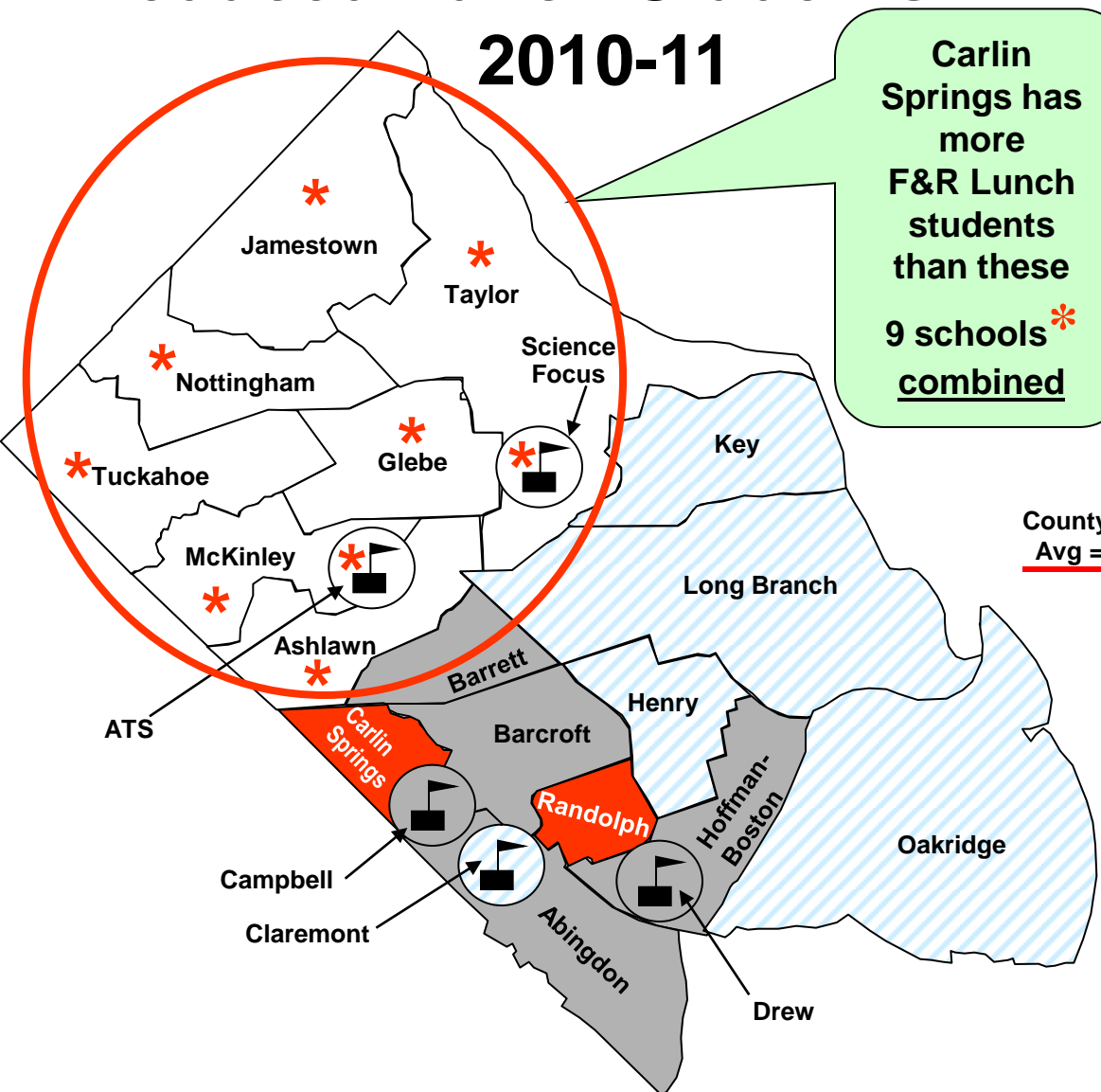
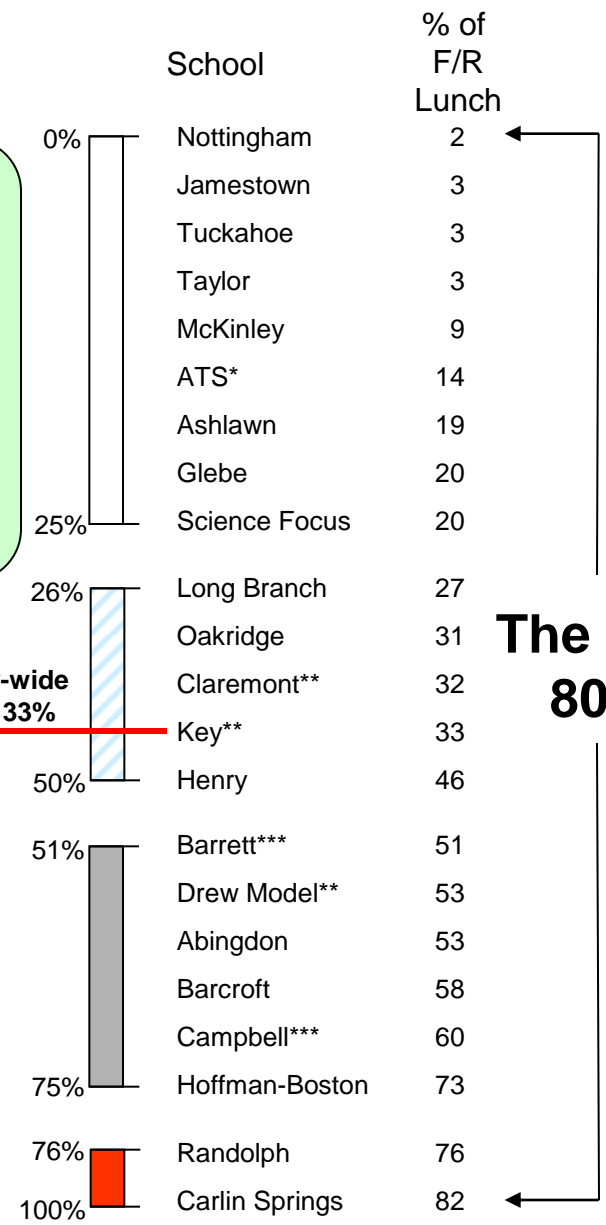


# Distribution of Free & Reduced Lunch Students 2010-11



Carlin Springs has more F&R Lunch students than these 9 schools combined



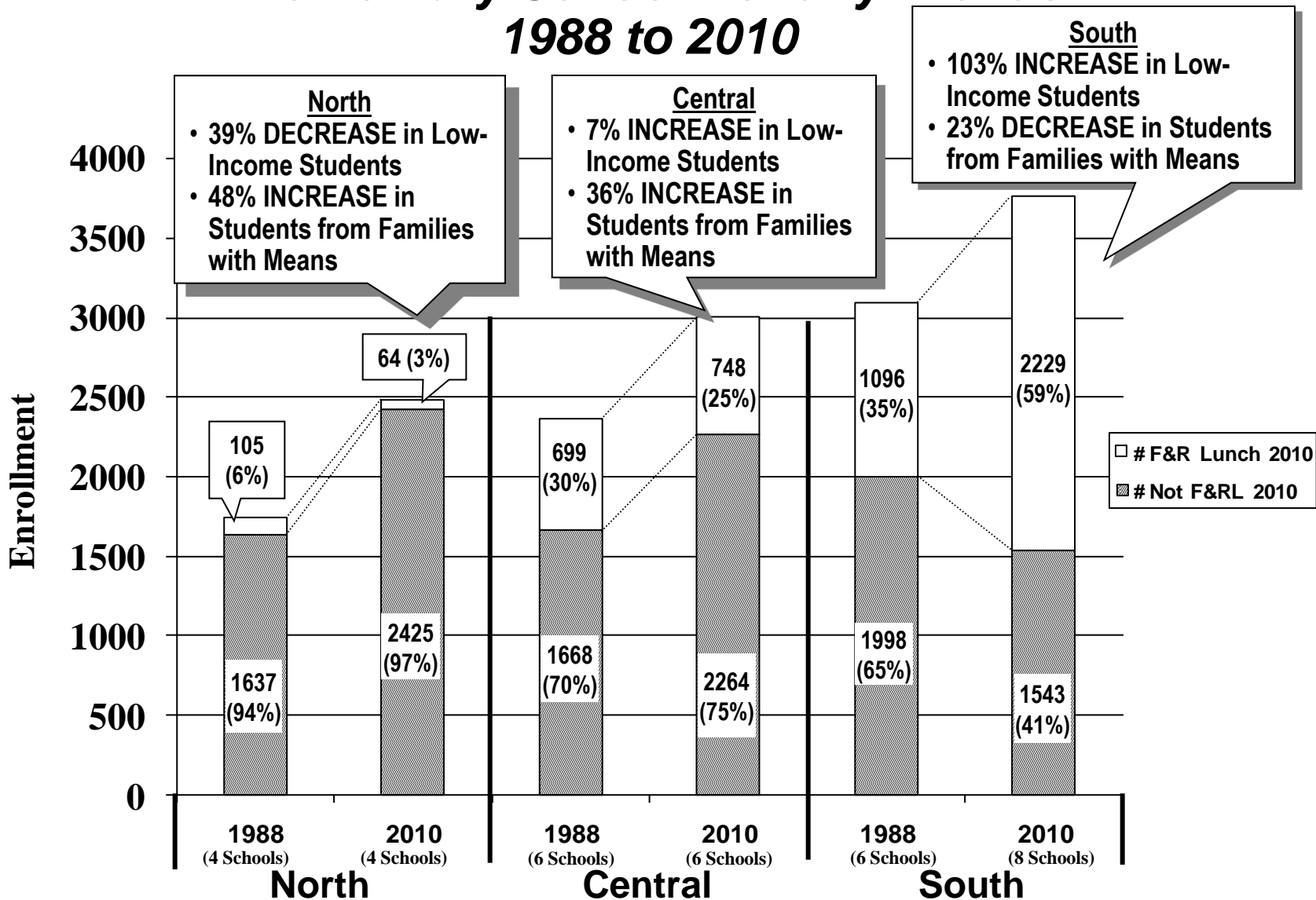
